## **FNAPEE Summary**

The First National Action Plan on EE is the first one of three required under the European Parliament and Council 2006/32/EO Directive on end-use energy efficiency and energy services - ESD. The Indicative National Targets (the respective overall reporting period after ESD is 2008 – 2016) for all MSs is to achieve fuel and energy savings of no less than 9 % from their final energy consumption during the 2001-2005 period. These targets do not apply for energy users in the European Community under the 2003/87/EC / 13.10.2003 Directive for eligible trading of greenhouse gas emissions.

The herewith presented FNAPEE covers 2008 – 2010 period of time, formulating respective National indicative interim Target to save fuels and energy amounting to 3 % from the final energy consumption during the 2001-2005 periods. All specific conditions and the way of this indicative target determining are related in detail in FNAPEE which uses the energy consumption data from the National Institute of Statistics. The material balances used there do not differ from the ones supplied by Eurostat.

There is huge potential for EE measures implementation in Bulgaria, quite respectively to the higher energy consumption, especially in household and in transport sectors – basis for the FNAPEE energy consumption forecasting in short and medium terms.

In support to the FNAPEE, parallel studies, analyses and actions on:

- energy services market development;
- EE White Certificates trading scheme;
- EE voluntary agreements mechanism

Could adjust number of important issues on reaching the National indicative Target EE measures implementation that require important financial resources, additional energy markets liberalization and larger application of PPP in all EE areas.

All currently implemented EE programs, projects and measures are not at all sufficient to reaching the FNAPEE objectives and targets that is why attracting more investments from the private sector, in need of strong motivation, in addition to the State aid is simply crucial.

In order to correctly evaluate the beneficial outcome from the EE measures implemented under the FNAPEE, specific methodologies for evaluation need to be further elaborated. In order to comply with the FNAPEE provisions and fully introduce the ESD in the National legislation, to implement soundly its requirements, Republic of Bulgaria should put in place additional normative, financial and administrative-organizational measures.
